WITHDRAWL

- Withdrawl from any class must be preceded by one month's notice in writing or month's fee in lieu notice.
- All dues have to be cleared before the Transfer Certificate is issued.
- Transfer Certificate will be issued after one week of receiving the application alongwith No-Dues Slip.

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES FOR THE PARENTS

- Don't forget to install DAVHP app from PLAY STORE
- Please use the diary and mobile app as a means of communication with the school, by checking the remarks, if any, made by the teachers.
- Please see that your ward has all the text books, items of stationery, craft material etc.
- Please ensure that he/she comes to the school in proper uniform and wears track suit on Monday & Friday(V-XII) and on Wednesday and Saturday(Nursery-IV).
- Please let your child not be absent from the school without proper written Application or information in mobile app.
- Please sign the test copies /papers when sent home.
- Please intimate the change of address or telephone to the school office.
- Please meet the teacher at prior appointment in the school. Please do not go to the class room to discuss problems as it disturbs the academic atmosphere of the class.
- In case you want to send lunch box, water bottles to your ward, please drop at reception after pasting the name & slip, same through the office.
- Please do not send money or valuable articles with the students, bracelet if any should be of minimum size only.
- Please do not send the fee with driver, conductor or any other member of the school staff.
- The late comers will not be permitted to attend the classes as the school gate will be closed after scheduled morning timings after 5 minutes relaxation time.
- Students are allowed to drive bikes (without gears) with helmet for coming to school with a driving licence as per the directions of the district administration. Motorcycles are not allowed.
- Please do not send the child to school in case of infectious disease and medical certificate should be furnished from a medical authority at the time of rejoining the school after illness.
- Students should carry school identity cards to school everyday.
- Students should not carry mobile phones, ipads, electronic gadgets to school. If found carrying in school premises, heavy fine will be imposed.
- Please do not send toffees on birthdays, instead you can send biscuits.
- As ID Cards are also issued to parents, so while collecting your ward from the school, please bring the same with you.

RULES FOR DEPOSITING FEE

- (Fee once deposited will not be refunded please)
- We prefer online fee to go transparent and paper free. Parents are not charged extra by bank for online fee transaction as per DAV College Managing Committee guidelines/understanding with the bank.
- To pay online go to school website www.advhudapnp.com
- Total fee for the 12 months from April to March will be charged in a year. Fee for the whole term will be charged in six installments as given below:
- April-May, June-July, August-September, October-November, December-January, February-March.
- Fee should be deposited by the tenth of every month. After 11th date late fee fine will be imposed as per details given on page no. 15 at the back of fee slip.
- At the time of admission; Admission fee, two months fee along with the transportation charges (if applicable) will be charged. In case of non payment of fee for three consecutive months the pupil name will be struck off without any prior intimation.

- Kindly deposit the fee of your ward using fee slip issued by the school only. In case the fee is deposited through RTGS/NEFT then kindly produce the supporting document in the school as soon as possible.
- Fee once paid will not be refunded or adjusted.
- Refund of security will be made one month after transfer certificate is applied for.
- Security can be claimed within three month of leaving school. After that it will be forfeited.
- School transport can be availed by filling stoppage in admission form/transport form. Discontinuation of transportinthe mid session will not be permitted.

- Fee cheque should be submitted only to bank official.
 Please don't drop after 10th of due month the applicable fine will be charged.

Name of the student shall be struck off from the school automatically if the fee is not paid with next installment till 5th date. A new Admission fee will have to be paid with all the due in case student intends to continue his/her studies in the school provided his/her seat has not been filled by another student and that too at the discretion of the Principal.

ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE RULES

- A student is expected to have minimum 75% attendance. If a student falls short of attendance, he/she shall not be eligible to take the annual examination.
- If a student is absent in any of the test examination without prior intimation the parents will have to pay the fine of Rs.100 per subject in periodic test. With prior permission from the principal, he/she may be exempted for that test otherwise will be treated as per CBSE policy.
- Parents should not plan holidays without consulting th school holiday calendar or without prior sanctioned from the school authorities through the leave application.
- Unsanctioned leave from school will be fined (emergencies will be looked into). Intimation can be send through school mobile app even. Please update leave on app before 7 o'clock.
- All students are expected to attend class on the opening day after each of the vacations.
- Absence because of ailment must be supported with a medical certificate. Students attending the school after suffering from an infectious disease such as measles, chickenpox, cholera, mumps, whooping cough etc. must produce fitness certificate from an authorized doctor. Students suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine.

Chicken pox Till the scabs fall off completely

Cholera Till the child has completely recovered Measles Two weeks after the rashes disappear

Mumps Untill the swelling has gone

Jaundice Six weeks

Corona Atleast after 15 days of +ve report.

ANY OTHER COMMUNICABLE/CONTAGIOUS DISEASE - CHILD SHOULD NOT BE SENT WITHOUT OBTAINING THE MEDICAL CERTIFICATE.

• Absence without leave is considered seriously and in case of 10 consecutive absences, the name of the student shall be struck off from the school Rolls. He/SHe will be readmitted after he/she has paid all the dues with fresh admission fee, at the discretion of the principal.

DIGITAL LIBRARY/LIBRARY RULES

- A student can borrow only one book at a time.
- Text books are not issued to the students.
- Passing on the issued books to fellow students is not allowed
- A student may ordinarily have a copy of the book for a week and the issue may be renewed further for the same period. A fine at the rate Rs.1/- per working day will be charged for the book returned late.
- Any book if lost should once be reported for the realization of cost or replacement as the case maybe.
- If the date of the return of book happens to be a holiday the return of the book shall be postponed to the next working day of the school.
- Making underline with Pen or Pencil in library book, annotating defacing of the books by any means is strictly forbidden.
- Any such injury to a book is a serious offence unless the borrower points out at the time of taking a book. He/she shall be required to replace the book with a new copy or pay its price.
- Talking or creating disturbance in the library is strictly forbidden. Strict order and silence shall be maintained in the library.
- Library book should be returned positively before the annual examination failing which they will not be allowed to appear in the examination.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION BY THE SCHOOL

The following categories of pupils may be required to be withdrawn from school:

- a. Those who fail to show satisfactory progress and are unwilling or unable to get benefited from the education programme of the school.
- b. Those whose fees is in arrears.
- c. Those whose behaviour and conduct in the opinion of the Principal is harmful to the interest of the school.
- d. Those who fail twice in the same class & are below average.

GUIDELINES BEFORE APPEARING IN EXAMINATION

- Parents are requested not to ask for leave or absence for students during evaluation schedule of examination except in case of emergency.
- Students will bring required material for examination themselves.
- Students will not be allowed to leave the examination room for water etc. before half time during the examination.
- Mobile, calculator or any other electronic gadgets are strictly prohibited in the school campus by the students.
- All the students must ensure the clearance of school dues/fee etc. before appearing in the exams as per fee depositing rules.
- Parents are requested not to collect their wards after completion of exam/assignment except in case of emergency.
- 75% attendance in the academic year is mandatory for promotion to the next class.
- If child is absent in any of exam then a valid proof and approval from principal is required before appearing in the next exam.
- No re-examination will be conducted on any ground including Medical.
